Subject: Ohio ~ Bulletin in Response to Severe Storms

On March 15, 2019, the Ohio Department of Insurance issued Bulletin 2019-01 in response to Governor DeWine's declaration of a State of Emergency due to severe storms and heavy rains that began February 5, 2019 and lasted through February 13, 2019.

This event affects the following counties:

Adams, Athens, Brown, Gallia, Guernsey, Hocking, Jackson, Jefferson, Lawrence, Meigs, Monroe, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble, Perry, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Vinton, and Washington

Any insured in the above counties must be offered the option of deferring premium payments coming due, interest free, for up to 60 calendar days from the original premium due date. This 60 calendar day period is not to extend past June 11, 2019. If an insured is affected in a county not listed above and does not make a required premium payment, please contact your underwriter for guidance before processing a notice of cancellation for nonpayment of premium.

This applies to both admitted and non-admitted business.
